Note: In this year's sample, child survivors (aged between 2 and 18) make up 55.17%. Adult survivors of childhood sexual abuse (up to 42 years of age) make up 44.83%. Reports of sexual abuse taking place outside Belgrade make up 32.14% of the total number of reports. Also, it is important to be aware of the fact that one offender abused one child in 79,31% of the cases, two children in 6.90% of the cases, and four children were victimized by the same offender in 13.79% of the cases. This data confirms the assumption that one child is usually just one of the minor victims of the same perpetrator. (Depending on whether the majority or possibly all the offences have been detected and reported)
